- ♦ The Peace through Folk Gathering 2024 13th −15th September was a fitting finale when it descended upon the Staffordshire Moorland village of Ipstones in Staffordshire-

Venues included St Leonards Church, The Methodist Church, and the Memorial Hall. The Gathering also spilled into the pubs and shops. 160 ticket holders, over 80 performers, 30 volunteer stewards, operation teams, and accommodation providers all worked together to make it a special weekend. The massive programme included concerts featuring solo artists, groups and choral workshops, Folk Clubs, singarounds and sessions.

Music, songs and good fellowship echoed throughout the village which took us to its heart.

That was the last of the three day Peace through Folk Gatherings.

To quote from Pete Seeger's song 'Quite Early Morning'

- 'keep on while we live, - until we have no more to give, and when these fingers can strum no longer, hand the old banjo to young ones stronger'.
